

# Displaying and Publishing Poetry Using Google Sites

## Requirements:

1. Change the **header**
2. Add and personalize **pages** (Between **3-10 pages**, you can choose how you'd like to organize them!)
3. Include a paragraph explaining your relationship with poetry (see guidelines below)
4. Include a page explaining your knowledge of the following:
  1. **Imagery (all types)**
  2. **Onomatopoeia**
  3. **Simile and Metaphor**
  4. **Syllables**
  5. **Rhyme, Rhyme Scheme, and Free Verse**
  6. **Dialect**
5. Proper **grammar, punctuation, spelling, cap. letters**, etc.
6. **Images** (4-10 extra images, not including the Paint Chip or Sidewalk poems)

## Poetry Requirements:

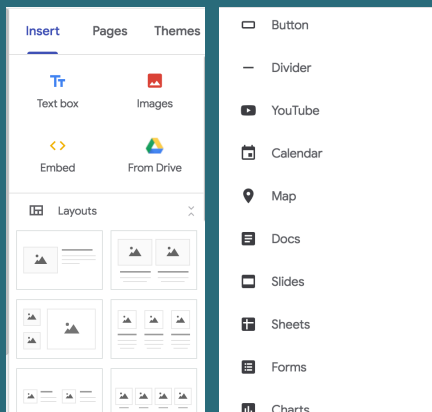
1. "Sisters" Relationship Poem

3. "Wolves" Imagery Poems (x2)
4. Haiku Poems (x6)
5. Cinquain Poems (x5)
6. Limericks (x6)
7. Paint Chip Poem (Image)
8. Sidewalk Ends Poem (Image)

## My Relationship with Poetry Paragraph Requirements:

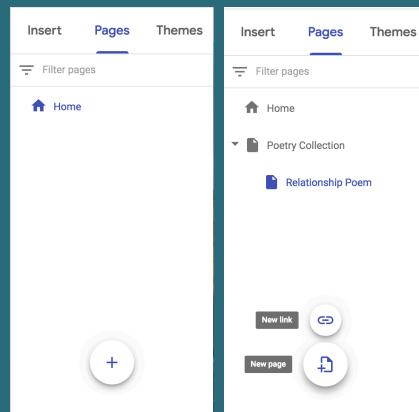

- What is one piece of advice you can offer to other poetry writers?

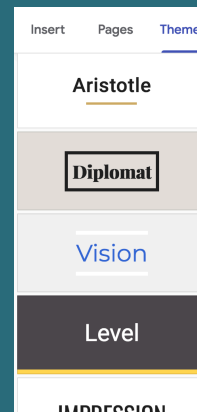
## Some things that may help you...



All of these items can be added to different sections to your home page or other pages. Be creative adding elements to make your website look cool!

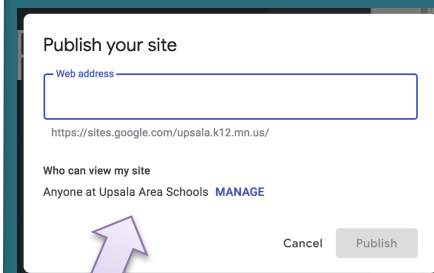


Creating pages is quite simple!
