What is a living donor? (Support #1)

A living donor is someone who is still alive and has not died yet. Some donors can stay living after they donate because they do not need the organ they donated, such as an extra liver, or piece of skin, or an extra eyeball, (Gondringer, 2018) (*Parenthetical*). Many people choose to donate their organs because they want to help other people. According to Johnson (2018) (*in-text*), organ donation can save up to eight lives so it's crucial for everyone to sign up to be an organ donor.
